## **NOTICE OF ERRATA**

The Department of Managed Health Care hereby provides notice of the following typographical errors in a summary table attached to All Plan Letter (APL) 24-021– *Notice of Amendments to Rules 1300.67.2.1, 1300.67.2 and Incorporated Documents – Network Adequacy Standards and Methodology for RY 2025* (Issued on December 12, 2024). Typographical errors are corrected in the attached document entitled “Mental Health Standards – Summary Tables for RY 2025”:

1. On tab “MHP Capacity” of the Mental Health Standards - Summary Tables for RY 2025, the “County Designation” column incorrectly lists certain county type designations, including those for Large Metro, Metro, Micro, and CEAC (Counties with Extreme Access Considerations) county types. The column is updated to list the corrected county type designations.
2. On tab “MHP Capacity” of the Mental Health Standards - Summary Tables for RY 2025, the “Alternative Methodology - Combined County Grouping Allowed” column lists the requirements for the incorrect county type listed in the “County Designation Column.” The column is updated with the corresponding standard for the corrected county type designation in the “County Designation” column.

The Mental Health Standards - Summary Tables for RY 2025 is amended to reflect updates to the errors mentioned above.
